## **Riceland Crawfish Sustainability Initiative**

Beaucoup Crawfish of Eunice, Inc. dba Riceland Crawfish is committed to sustainability as it relates to the seafood products that we process.

The company has formed a sustainability advisory committee to support the Audubon Nature Institute's Gulf United for Lasting Fisheries (G.U.L.F) efforts to develop a crawfish sustainability program. This committee is comprised of aquaculture and water quality specialists with the LSU Ag Center, marketing specialists with the LA Farm Bureau Federation, and a representative from the Louisiana Department of Agriculture. Riceland Crawfish has also signed a letter of agreement with G.U.L.F. to serve on its Fisheries Improvement Project (FIP) whose goal is to verify and develop a sustainability certification model for the industry.

Riceland Crawfish acquires locally grown raw products from fisherman and producers who follow LSU Ag Center and Natural Resources and Conservation Service recommended production and best management practices designed to enhance the sustainability of the environment where these products are grown.

When processing Riceland Crawfish follows all HACCP guidelines and has on staff Certified SQF and HACCP Practitioners that conduct daily performance inspections. The processing plant is inspected annually by FDA and the Louisiana Department of Agriculture. On a monthly basis the State Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH) conducts HACCP inspections and the company meets local government regulatory agency requirements. Additionally, Riceland Crawfish undergoes annual 3<sup>rd</sup> party HACCP and Traceability inspections under SQF guidelines.
