1. Attain INAB accreditation for the Chain of Custody (CoC) Standard
2. Continued review/consideration of Public Comments received during Public Comment periods held in 2017
3. Attain INAB accreditation for RFM Certification Standard, Version 1.2
4. Continued development of a Data Deficient Assessment Tool (DDAT) as a supplemental component of the Audubon G.U.L.F. RFM Certification Program.
5. Completion of Global Sustainable Seafood Initiative (GSSI) Benchmarking and GSSI recognition
